



## PROPHECY AGAIN

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**OBAMA: WORLD IS BENEFITING FROM JESUIT PRINCIPLES!  
POPE: STUDY THEM TO KNOW ME! TRIBULATION AHEAD**

1. What did Jesus' disciples ask Him? Matthew 24:3 \_\_\_\_\_
2. Note: Throughout Matthew 24 we find signs that precede the literal destruction of Jerusalem in A.D. 70, and also signs that precede the second coming of Jesus and the destruction of the world.
3. What was one of the things that Jesus said His church would encounter? Matthew 24:21,22 \_\_\_\_\_
4. God's church went through great tribulation during a specific time period. There is a greater tribulation ahead of us in these last days. Daniel 12:1
5. What was the time period of this great tribulation of persecution for God's church? Revelation 12:6,14 \_\_\_\_\_  
"The 1260 years of papal supremacy began in A.D. 538, and would therefore terminate in 1798... **The persecution of the church did not continue throughout the entire period of the 1260 years.** God in mercy to His people **cut short the time of their fiery trial...** Through the influence of the Reformation the persecution was brought to **an end prior to 1798.**" {GC 266.4}
6. How many years prior to 1798 did persecution cease for God's church? \_\_\_\_\_  
"The 1260 days, or years, terminated in 1798. **A quarter of a century earlier, persecution had almost wholly ceased.**" {GC 306.1}
7. Note: A quarter of a century, or 25 years, prior to 1798 is 1773.
8. What significant event took place in 1773 that caused persecution against God's church to almost wholly cease? \_\_\_\_\_  
"As the Inquisition was the tribulum by which the Papacy inflicted such sore tribulation upon the church, and as **the Order of the Jesuits was the strength of the Inquisition**, therefore we believe that the abolition of **the Order of the Jesuits** is the event that marks the end of the tribulation. They had been expelled from Portugal in 1753, from France in 1761, and from Spain in 1767; but these decrees could not be permanently successful **as long as the Jesuits retained their Order intact, and had the support of the Pope.** But it was not long before the Pope was forced to turn against them, and the final crash came. {August 12, 1886 ATJ, SITI 487.10}  
"At last came the final blow that was to shatter into pieces the great army of Loyola. For more than two centuries the Jesuits had been lighting the battles of Rome. To exalt the supremacy of the Pope, they had died by thousands in English jails and Indian solitudes, had pierced land and sea to carry the strange story of the primacy to heathen millions, and to build anew the medieval church in the heart of Oriental idolatry. And now it was the Pope and Rome that were to complete their destruction. By a cruel ingratitude, the deity on earth whom they had worshiped with a fidelity unequaled among men, was to hurl his anathemas against his most faithful disciples. **France and Spain elected Pope Clement XIV. upon his pledge that he would dissolve the Order. He issued his bull July 21, 1773, directing that, for the welfare of the church and the good of mankind, the institution of Loyola should be abolished.**" Historical Studies, Id. {August 12, 1886 ATJ, SITI 487.11} **For these reasons we believe that the abolition of the Order of Jesuits is the event, and July 21, 1773, is the date, when "the tribulation of those days" ended.** {August 12, 1886 ATJ, SITI 487.12}
9. Note: The Jesuit Order was abolished in 1773.
10. Note: The Papacy received its deadly wound in 1798. See the following. Revelation 13:3,10.  
"Power was given unto him to continue forty and two months." And, says the prophet, "I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death." And again: "He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword." The forty and two months are the same as the "time and times and the dividing of time," three years and a half, or 1260 days, of Daniel 7 - - the time during which the papal power was to oppress God's people. This period, as stated in preceding chapters, began with the supremacy of the papacy, A.D. 538, and terminated in 1798. At that time the pope was made captive by the French army, the papal power received its deadly wound, and the prediction was fulfilled, "He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity." {GC 439.2}  
At that time a French army entered Rome and made the pope a prisoner, and he died in exile. Though a new pope was soon afterward elected, the papal hierarchy has never since been able to wield the power which it before possessed. {GC 266.3}
11. Note: After 1798, the Protestant Reformation was revived and Bibles were mass-produced and distributed by missionaries.  
"In 1804 the British and Foreign Bible Society was organized. This was followed by similar organizations, with numerous branches, upon the continent of Europe. **In 1816 the American Bible Society was founded.** When the British Society was formed, the Bible had been printed and circulated in fifty tongues. It has since been translated into many hundreds of languages and dialects... **From this time the work of foreign missions attained an unprecedented growth.**" {GC 287.2}
12. What happened after 1798 as the Protestant Reformation was revived and true Christianity was taught and preached worldwide? \_\_\_\_\_  
**"The Jesuits were restored in 1814, by Pope Pius VII.;** but not to their persecuting power. In the different countries of Europe since that time the Order has been expelled and restored several times, and even by the Papacy once. **But Pius IX., after his return from Gaeta in 1849, gave them its entire confidence till the day of his death, and in his Vatican decrees is seen the crowning triumph of Jesuit Ultramontanism.** {August 12, 1886 ATJ, SITI 487.13}  
**The movements of the Protestant Church in the early part of this century, alarmed the Roman Pontiff, Pius VII., and induced him, in 1814, to restore the Jesuits to all their former privileges,** and to call upon Papists to afford them protection and all necessary assistance." {April 27, 1842 JVHe, HST 26.15}

13. Note: The Order of Jesuits was restored, reestablished in 1814.

14. What was the primary purpose of the Order of the Jesuits? \_\_\_\_\_

“The Papal Church is bound to protect the Jesuits, and the latter to do what they can to promote the interest of the former.” {April 27, 1842 JVHe, HST 27.1}

15a. Note: Since the Order of the Jesuits was restored in 1814 to combat Protestantism, this is the entity that is working aggressively to bring the Papacy back to world dominance and to persecute God’s people.

16. Note: It is a startling fact that pope Francis is the first publicly announced Jesuit pope. Both entities, Jesuitism and Popery, are merged into one office for the first time in modern history.

A portion of the Jesuit oath reads as follows: “I furthermore promise and declare that I will, when opportunity present, make and wage relentless war, secretly or openly, against all heretics, Protestants and Liberals, as I am directed to do, to extirpate and exterminate them from the face of the whole earth; and that I will spare neither age, sex or condition; and that I will hang, waste, boil, flay, strangle and bury alive these infamous heretics, rip up the stomachs and wombs of their women and crush their infants’ heads against the walls, in order to annihilate forever their execrable race. That when the same cannot be done openly, I will secretly use the poisoned cup, the strangulating cord, the steel of the poniard or the leaden bullet, regardless of the honor, rank, dignity, or authority of the person or persons, whatever may be their condition in life, either public or private, as I at any time may be directed so to do by any agent of the Pope or Superior of the Brotherhood of the Holy Faith, of the Society of Jesus.” <http://www.reformation.org/jesuit-oath.html>

19. What is the objective of Jesuitism in these last days that has ever been their aim? \_\_\_\_\_

“Vowed to perpetual poverty and humility, it was their studied aim to secure wealth and power, **to be devoted to the overthrow of Protestantism, and the re-establishment of the papal supremacy.**” {GC 234.2}

20. What are some of the primary methods that the Jesuits would use to accomplish their objective? \_\_\_\_\_

“Under various disguises **the Jesuits worked their way into offices of state, climbing up to be the counselors of kings, and shaping the policy of nations.** They became servants to act as spies upon their masters. **They established colleges for the sons of princes and nobles, and schools for the common people; and the children of Protestant parents were drawn into an observance of popish rites.** The Jesuits rapidly spread themselves over Europe, and **wherever they went, there followed a revival of popery.**” {GC 235.1}

“A lot’s happened in Washington over two centuries and Hoyas have always been at the center of the action,” Obama said in his tribute. “Simply put, this country and this word benefit from your commitment to Jesuit principles, to being men and women for others. 25. What steps is Pope Francis, the Jesuit, taking that will bring persecution against God’s faithful people? Answer: Pope Francis’ relentless agenda to implement policies to combat what he calls climate change.

**26a.** According to history, Sunday observance and persecution were firmly rooted in society by the Papacy, when she deceived people to honor Sunday in order to stop the calamities. See the following statement.

**26b.** "Later the pope gave directions that the parish priest should admonish the violators of Sunday and wish them to go to church and say their prayers, lest they bring some great calamity on themselves and neighbors. An ecclesiastical council brought forward the argument, since so widely employed, even by Protestants, that because persons had been struck by lightning while laboring on Sunday, it must be the Sabbath. "It is apparent," said the prelates, "how high the displeasure of God was upon their neglect of this day." An appeal was then made that priests and ministers, kings and princes, and all faithful people "use their utmost endeavors and care that the day be restored to its honor, and, for the credit of Christianity, more devoutly observed for the time to come." {GC 575.2}

The decrees of councils proving insufficient, the secular authorities were besought to issue an edict that would strike terror to the hearts of the people and force them to refrain from labor on the Sunday. At a synod held in Rome, all previous decisions were reaffirmed with greater force and solemnity. They were also incorporated into the ecclesiastical law and enforced by the civil authorities throughout nearly all Christendom. (See Heylyn, History of the Sabbath, pt. 2, ch. 5, sec. 7.) {GC 575.3}

**26c.** It will be declared that men are offending God by the violation of the Sunday sabbath; that this sin has brought calamities which will not cease until Sunday observance shall be strictly enforced; and that those who present the claims of the fourth commandment, thus destroying reverence for Sunday, are troublers of the people, preventing their restoration to divine favor and temporal prosperity. Thus the accusation urged of old against the servant of God will be repeated and upon grounds equally well established: "And it came to pass, when Ahab saw Elijah, that Ahab said unto him, Art thou he that troubleth Israel? And he answered, I have not troubled Israel; but thou, and thy father's house, in that ye have forsaken the commandments of the Lord, and thou hast followed Baalim." 1 Kings 18:17, 18. As the wrath of the people shall be excited by false charges, they will pursue a course toward God's ambassadors very similar to that which apostate Israel pursued toward Elijah. {GC 590.1}

**32.** Note: Many conservatives and so-called present-truth teachers and preachers will have to wake up to the reality that they will not be tolerated any longer in the church if they plan to uphold truth and address the issues in the church. They believe as long as they tell people stay in the conference churches and return their tithe to the conference that the apostate leaders will give them recognition and opportunity to voice their position.
