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IMAGE OF GOLD SHOWS BABYLON'S 2 GREAT ERRORS TO DECEIVE AND DEFY PROPHECY! BABYLON IS FALLEN, IS FALLEN!

1. What did the Lord give to Nebuchadnezzar and what happened afterwards? Daniel 2:1-5 _____
2. Who was brought before Nebuchadnezzar to remind him of his dream with the interpretation? Daniel 2:14-23 _____
3. What did Nebuchadnezzar's dream entail, as Daniel reminded him? Daniel 2:31-35 _____

4. What did Daniel say as he interpreted the king's dream? Daniel 2:-36-45 _____

5. What did Daniel say specifically to Nebuchadnezzar regarding Babylon? Daniel 2:37-39 _____
6. Note: Daniel told king Nebuchadnezzar that his kingdom of Babylon would fall. Consider the fact that Daniel was dwelling in Babylon, yet in the presence of Nebuchadnezzar, he said that Babylon would fall. The thing that gave Daniel such boldness, confidence, and assurance was that the message of the fall of Babylon came from the God of creation. Again, Daniel preached the message that Babylon would fall.
7. What message forms a part of the everlasting gospel that God's messengers must proclaim in these last days? Revelation 14:6-8; Revelation 18:1-4 _____
8. Note: The sad reality is that the majority of Seventh-day Adventist pastors are afraid to identify who mystery Babylon is and who the daughters of Babylon are (Revelation 17:1-6), and tell the world that Babylon is fallen, is fallen.
9. What did Nebuchadnezzar do, after Daniel reminded him of the dream and gave him the interpretation? Daniel 3:1 _____
10. Note: Nebuchadnezzar erected an image of only gold. This action by Nebuchadnezzar implied that Babylon would not fall; he was attempting to defy God's prophecy that said that Babylon would fall.
11. What did Nebuchadnezzar command the people to do, once the image of gold was erected? Daniel 3:1-6 _____
12. Note: Bear in mind that the erection of the image of gold was Nebuchadnezzar's sign that Babylon would not fall. In order to preserve the kingdom from falling, the people were commanded to bow down and worship.
13. Whose voice today is leading the movement to preserve the world from calamities? Answer: Pope Francis.
14. What does Pope Francis say is the primary thing to be enacted, in order to preserve the world from calamities? Answer: The Sunday Law

237. **On Sunday, our participation in the Eucharist has special importance. Sunday, like the Jewish Sabbath, is meant to be a day which heals our relationships with God, with ourselves, with others and with the world...The law of weekly rest forbade work on the seventh day,** "so that your ox and your donkey may have rest, and the son of your maidservant, and the stranger, may be refreshed" (Ex 23:12). **Rest opens our eyes to the larger picture and gives us renewed sensitivity to the rights of others. 15. Note: As ancient Babylon did, so mystery Babylon is doing today.
16. The following shows that even the Buddhists are adhering to Pope Francis's call for Sunday to be enacted by law, in order to preserve the world from calamities.
"With Pope Francis's call for action on climate change and unprecedented destruction of ecosystems earlier in the year, it is becoming apparent that more and more people are voicing their concerns publicly for the welfare of the planet and humankind...Fifteen of the world's most senior Buddhists have issued a landmark call to political leaders to adopt an effective climate change agreement at the UN negotiations in Paris starting 30 November." <http://www.collective-evolution.com/2015/11/04/1-billion-buddhists-urge-for-action-on-climate-change/>
17. Note: The gathering of the world leaders in Paris, in December 2015, will show us how close we are to the enforcing of the Sunday Law to preserve the world from calamities.
18. Who refused to bow down and worship the image of gold? Daniel 3:12-18 _____
19. Note: The three Hebrews refused to bow and worship the image of gold, because that would have meant that they agreed with Nebuchadnezzar that Babylon would not fall. However, the three Hebrews knew from God, through Daniel, that Babylon would fall.
20. Note: Therefore, anyone who accepts Sunday when it becomes the law of the nations to preserve the world from destruction, will be rejecting the everlasting gospel of Revelation 14: 6-12 and Revelation 18:1-4, and God's word that this world will end.
21. What did Nebuchadnezzar say would happen to anyone who refused to bow down and worship the image of gold, in order to preserve the kingdom of Babylon from falling? Daniel 3:6,15 _____
22. What will happen to God's people who refuse to honor Sunday when it becomes the law of the nations, in order to preserve the world from calamities? Revelation 13:13-17 _____
23. Note: The erection of the image of gold by Nebuchadnezzar is revealing to us another kindred error that is connected to him commanding people to bow down and worship falsely.

24. Note: Nebuchadnezzar was proclaiming to the world, by the act of erecting the image of gold, that he possessed natural immortality, that he was immortal. To confirm this point, remember that the erection of the image of only gold was Nebuchadnezzar's sign that the kingdom of Babylon would not fall; and the image of gold resembled Nebuchadnezzar. Therefore, Nebuchadnezzar was stating that Babylon would not fall and that he would not fall, he would not be destroyed, he would live on. Surely, Nebuchadnezzar knew that one day breath would leave his body, just as his forefathers. But he believed, just as other pagans, that when breath leaves the body, the soul is still alive. Therefore, the erection of the image of gold by Nebuchadnezzar reveals to us the two great errors, namely the natural immortality of the soul (communication with "the dead," with devils) and false worship (Sunday worship).

25. Additionally, Nebuchadnezzar was proclaiming that should breath leave his body, the people should pray and worship him and he will preserve the kingdom from destruction.

26. Which church today has leaders that teach their members to pray to the dead, so that the dead might protect them and that the world might be preserved from calamities? Answer: The Papacy.

27. However, when does the Bible say that God's faithful people will receive immortality? 1 Corinthians 15:52-54; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-18

28. Furthermore, who alone has immortality? 1 Timothy 6:14-16

29. What does the Bible say happens after death, once breath leaves the body? Ecclesiastes 9:5,6,10

30. What lie did Satan communicate to Eve? Genesis 3:4

31. Note: Ministers today reecho to the people Satan's lie that when the breath leaves a person's body that their soul lives on. This would mean then that the person never dies, natural immortality of the soul.

32. However, what does the Bible say? Genesis 2:7; Acts 27:37; Ezekiel 18:20

33. Note: Once breath leaves the body, the soul dies, because it takes the combination of the breath and the body to compose a soul.

34. Note: If a person is visited by an appearance of a dead relative or friend, who is it? Answer: A demon personating the dead. See 2 Corinthians 11:13-15.

35. Consider again the fact that in the erection of the image of gold by Nebuchadnezzar we see the two great errors, namely the natural immortality of the soul which leads to communication with "the dead," with devils and false worship, in the context of preserving the world from destruction. The application is that in these last days these two great errors will be used to "preserve the world from destruction."

36a. However what does the Lord's messenger say?

"It will be declared that men are offending God by the violation of the Sunday sabbath; **that this sin has brought calamities which will not cease until Sunday observance shall be strictly enforced...** The miracle-working power manifested through spiritualism will exert its influence against those who choose to obey God rather than men. **Communications from the [evil] spirits will declare that God has sent them to convince the rejecters of Sunday of their error, affirming that the laws of the land should be obeyed as the law of God. They will lament the great wickedness in the world and second the testimony of religious teachers that the degraded state of morals is caused by the desecration of Sunday.** Great will be the indignation excited against all who refuse to accept their testimony." {GC 590.2}

36b. **"Through the two great errors, the immortality of the soul and Sunday sacredness, Satan will bring the people under his deceptions.** While the former lays the foundation of spiritualism, the latter creates a bond of sympathy with Rome. **The Protestants of the United States will be foremost in stretching their hands across the gulf to grasp the hand of spiritualism; they will reach over the abyss to clasp hands with the Roman power;** and under the influence of this threefold union, this country will follow in the steps of Rome in trampling on the rights of conscience." {GC 588.1}

37a. The following shows how Pope Francis is using the lie of the natural immortality of the soul and communication with "the dead" to deceive the world.

38. What words will the devils use in the attempt to deceive God's people? _____
"I saw that the saints must get a thorough understanding of present truth, which they will be obliged to maintain from the Scriptures. **They must understand the state of the dead; for the spirits of devils will yet appear to them, professing to be beloved friends and relatives, who will declare to them that the Sabbath has been changed, also other unscriptural doctrines.** They will do all in their power to excite sympathy and will work miracles before them to confirm what they declare. **The people of God must be prepared to withstand these spirits with the Bible truth that the dead know not anything, and that they who appear to them are the spirits of devils. Our minds must not be taken up with things around us, but must be occupied with the present truth and a preparation to give a reason of our hope with meekness and fear.** We must seek wisdom from on high that we may stand in this day of error and delusion." {EW 87.2}

39a. What does the Lord's messenger say? _____
"The prince of darkness, who has so long bent the powers of his mastermind to the work of deception, skillfully adapts his temptations to men of all classes and conditions. **To persons of culture and refinement he presents spiritualism in its more refined and intellectual aspects, and thus succeeds in drawing many into his snare.**" {GC 553.3}

40. What does the Lord's messenger say? _____
His [Satan's] agents still claim to cure disease. They attribute their power to electricity, magnetism, or the so-called "sympathetic remedies." In truth, they are but channels for Satan's electric currents. By this means he casts his spell over the bodies and souls of men. {5T 193.2}

The apostles of nearly all forms of spiritism claim to have the power to cure the diseased. They attribute their power to electricity, magnetism, the so-called "sympathetic remedies," or to latent forces within the mind of man. And there are not a few, even in this Christian age, who go to these healers, instead of trusting in the power of the living God and the skill of well-qualified Christian physicians. {Ev 606.2}

The brain nerves which communicate with the entire system are the only medium through which Heaven can communicate to man, and affect his inmost life. Whatever disturbs the circulation of the electric currents in the nervous system, lessens the strength of the vital powers, and the result is a deadening of the sensibilities of the mind. {CH 616.2}

42. Note: Just before Saul died, he was found communicating with Satan's witch and with a demon. See 1 Samuel 28:7-20.

43. Note: Since the dead know not anything, the figure acting like Samuel was not him, but a demon personating Samuel.

44. Let us analyze carefully, what led to the demise of Saul; he made shipwreck of faith. His experience will be repeated in these last days.

45. What did Samuel do to Saul, just before he was placed as king? 1 Samuel 10:1 _____

46. How does the Bible describe Saul after his anointing? 1 Samuel 10:1,6,9 _____

47. Note: Saul represents people who were once baptized and converted.

48. Note: Let us examine the first failure of Saul.

49. What did Samuel tell Saul to do, when he encountered a crisis? 1 Samuel 10:8; 1 Samuel 13:5-8 _____

50. Note: In other words, Samuel told Saul just wait seven days until he arrived. Do not murmur, do not be afraid, do not break God's commandments in the attempt to deliver yourself, just wait. Since the number seven represents completion and perfection (Genesis 2:2,3 and Exodus 20:8-11). The Lord had sent the trial and delayed Samuel, so that Saul's faith could be perfected. But Saul failed the test.

"Saul had failed to bear the test of faith in the trying situation at Gilgal, and had brought dishonor upon the service of God; but his errors were not yet irretrievable, and the Lord would grant him another opportunity to learn the lesson of unquestioning faith in His word and obedience to His commands." {PP 627.1}

59. Note: The following is the application. What does the Lord ask us to utterly destroy and trample upon? Answer: Sin! Yet many people like Saul are calling good what God has called evil, and are using those things to worship Him. See Isaiah 5:20.
60. What did the Lord say to Samuel regarding Saul? What were their emotions? 1 Samuel 15:11 _____
Saul had now been subjected to the final test. His presumptuous disregard of the will of God, showing his determination to rule as an independent monarch, proved that he could not be trusted with royal power as the vicegerent of the Lord. While Saul and his army were marching home in the flush of victory, there was deep anguish in the home of Samuel the prophet. **He had received a message from the Lord denouncing the course of the king: "It repenteth Me that I have set up Saul to be king: for he is turned back from following Me, and hath not performed My commandments."** The prophet was deeply grieved over the course of the rebellious king, and he wept and prayed all night for a reversing of the terrible sentence. {PP 629.3}
God's repentance is not like man's repentance. "The Strength of Israel will not lie nor repent: for He is not a man, that He should repent." **Man's repentance implies a change of mind. God's repentance implies a change of circumstances and relations.** Man may change his relation to God by complying with the conditions upon which he may be brought into the divine favor, or he may, by his own action, place himself outside the favoring condition; but the Lord is the same "yesterday, and today, and forever." Hebrews 13:8. **Saul's disobedience changed his relation to God; but the conditions of acceptance with God were unaltered**--God's requirements were still the same, for with Him there "is no variableness, neither shadow of turning." James 1:17. {PP 630.1}
