



PROPHECY AGAIN

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WORLD DEEMS POPE AS NOAH, SDAs ABOARD CLIMATE CHANGE ARK, THEY FIGHT BELIEVERS OF ABSOLUTE TRUTH

1. Let us read Matthew 24:37-39 and discover that the Bible says that as it was in the days of Noah, so shall it be in the last days.
2. What did the Lord tell Noah to preach for 120 years? Genesis 6:3,13, and 17 _____
3. What did the Lord tell Noah to build to preserve the faithful from the coming flood of destruction? Genesis 6:14 _____
4. Did the flood come as Noah preached and as the Lord promised? Genesis 7:10-12 and 16-19 _____
5. Note: Dear reader, have you ever thought about the fact that the message that Noah preached regarding the coming flood of destruction upon the earth would be counterfeited in these last days? Bear in mind that the word "counterfeit" means to make something valuable or important with the intention to deceive or defraud.
- 6a. Note: Pope Francis has counterfeited the message of Noah that a great flood of destruction is coming to destroy the world due to climate change. "The top five things Pope Francis gets totally right about climate change... These include sea level rise, changes in global weather patterns, agricultural losses, declines in water quality and availability, reductions in biodiversity and even the potential for forced migrations and civil unrest." <https://www.washingtonpost.com/news/energy-environment/wp/2015/09/22/the-top-five-things-pope-francis-gets-totally-right-about-climate-change/>

- 6b. "Officials from around the world reach climate change draft agreement...Negotiators from 195 countries agreed Saturday on a blueprint deal aimed at reducing global carbon emissions and limiting global warming, a significant but far from conclusive step in the multinational effort to keep climate change in check. Officials will now work through next week at the COP21 conference in Paris to craft a complete, final agreement. Doing so may not be easy, but that didn't stop those involved in the process from celebrating Saturday's announcement." <http://www.cnn.com/2015/12/05/world/global-climate-change-draft-agreement/index.html>
7. Note: As Noah built the ark to preserve the faithful from the flood of destruction, Pope Francis has stated that the nations must accept and implement the instructions given in *Laudato Si* (his encyclical on climate change) to preserve the world from destruction. In other words, *Laudato Si* is the Pope's ark of safety. The following news reports show that the consensus in the world is that *Laudato Si* is the ark of safety.
"We should see the Encyclical [*Laudato Si*] as a message of hope: we can tackle climate change effectively, and in so doing we will improve the lives of all people, in current and future generations. We are all journeying together on a Great Ark. - 8a. Note: One primary reason why *Laudato Si* could not be the ark of safety, is that it leads people into Sunday worship. "And so the day of rest [Sunday], centred on the Eucharist, sheds it light on the whole week, and motivates us to greater concern for nature and the poor." http://w2.vatican.va/content/francesco/en/encyclicals/documents/papa-francesco_20150524_enciclica-laudato-si.html
- 8b. On the contrary, the ark that God told Noah to build to preserve the lives of the faithful had three levels or three stories (Genesis 6:16).
- 8c. Since the Lord does not tell us to build a literal ark for safety in these last days, what three-fold message or ark has the Lord given to save mankind? Answer: It is the three angels' messages of Revelation 14:6-12.
- 9a. Note: The following news reports insinuate that Pope Francis is the modern-day Noah. "Climate Change Encyclical: Is the Pope a Prophet of Doom or a Modern Day Noah?... The end of the world did finally happen. Noah, was right when the flood finally came. - 9b. Note: The movie, "Noah, the Global Warming Epic" received a thumbs up from Pope Francis. "Pope Francis reportedly gave the film the Vatican's blessing after a brief tête-à-tête with the film's burly star, Russell Crowe." <http://www.thedailybeast.com/articles/2014/03/27/noah-is-a-global-warming-epic-about-the-battle-between-religion-and-science-says-cinematographer.html>
10. Note: Since Noah's message regarding the coming flood of destruction is now being counterfeited, it means that we are living in the last days; for as it was in the days of Noah, so shall it be in the last days when Jesus returns.
- 11a. Note: The words of Pope Francis that the policies of *Laudato Si* must be implemented by the nations to preserve the world from the flood of destruction is an echo of the words of Nimrod. Bear in mind that Nimrod instructed the people to build the Tower of Babel, a system of false worship, to preserve the world from another flood of destruction. See Genesis 10:8-10 and Genesis 11:3,4. In scripture a tower is primarily associated with a place of worship, a religious entity. See 2 Samuel 22:51; Proverbs 18:10; Psalm 18:2.

11b. **“One object before them in the erection of the tower was to secure their own safety in case of another deluge. By carrying the structure to a much greater height than was reached by the waters of the Flood, they thought to place themselves beyond all possibility of danger. And as they would be able to ascend to the region of the clouds, they hoped to ascertain the cause of the Flood. The whole undertaking was designed to exalt still further the pride of its projectors and to turn the minds of future generations away from God and lead them into idolatry. {Patriarch and Prophets, 119.1}**

12. Note: It was the descendants of Shem that helped to build that Tower of Babel. Bear in mind that through Shem's descendants the Messiah would come. Read carefully the following.

“The line of Shem was to be that of the chosen people, of God's covenant, of the promised Redeemer. Jehovah was the God of Shem. From him would descend Abraham, and the people of Israel, through whom Christ was to come...Noah, the faithful preacher of righteousness, lived for three hundred and fifty years after the Flood, Shem for five hundred years, and thus their descendants had an opportunity to become acquainted with the requirements of God and the history of His dealings with their fathers. But they were unwilling to listen to these unpalatable truths; they had no desire to retain God in their knowledge; and by the confusion of tongues they were, in a great measure, shut out from intercourse with those who might have given them light.” {Patriarch and Prophets, 117.3 and 120.2}

13a. Note: The application of the above point is that Seventh-day Adventist leaders are in harmony with Pope Francis' policies to combat climate change. Read the following news from the Seventh-day Adventists.

“As world leaders gather in Paris for the 21st United Nations Climate Change Conference, the Seventh-day Adventist Church supports and applauds the efforts of these leaders to come to an agreement to stem the deterioration of our earth due to climate change. Increasingly men and women have been involved in a megalomaniacal destruction of the earth's resources, resulting in widespread suffering, environmental disarray, and the threat of climate change...It is clear from the accumulated evidence that the increasing emission of destructive gasses, the depletion of the protective mantle of ozone, the massive destruction of the American forests, and the so-called greenhouse effect, are all threatening the earth's eco-system...Seventh-day Adventists advocate a simple, wholesome lifestyle, where people do not step on the treadmill of unbridled consumerism, goods-getting, and production of waste. We call for respect of creation, restraint in the use of the world's resources, reevaluation of one's needs, and reaffirmation of the dignity of created life.” <http://news.adventist.org/en/all-news/news/go/2015-12-03/seventh-day-adventists-reaffirm-commitment-to-preserving-the-environment/>

13b. Note: The rhetoric from the Seventh-day Adventist leaders are direct quotes from Pope Francis' playbook of addressing climate change.

13c. However, what does the Lord's messenger say?

“Yet this very class put forth the claim that the fast-spreading corruption is largely attributable to the desecration of the so-called ‘Christian sabbath,’ and that the enforcement of Sunday observance would greatly improve the morals of society. This claim is especially urged in America, where the doctrine of the true Sabbath has been most widely preached. Here the temperance work, one of the most prominent and important of moral reforms, is often combined with the Sunday movement, and the advocates of the latter represent themselves as laboring to promote the highest interest of society; and those who refuse to unite with them are denounced as the enemies of temperance and reform. But the fact that a movement to establish error is connected with a work which is in itself good, is not an argument in favor of the error. We may disguise poison by mingling it with wholesome food, but we do not change its nature. On the contrary, it is rendered more dangerous, as it is more likely to be taken unawares. It is one of Satan's devices to combine with falsehood just enough truth to give it plausibility. The leaders of the Sunday movement may advocate reforms which the people need, principles which are in harmony with the Bible; yet while there is with these a requirement which is contrary to God's law, His servants cannot unite with them. Nothing can justify them in setting aside the commandments of God for the precepts of men.” {GC 587.1}

13d. **“Do Adventists Have a Beef With Pope Francis?” <http://www.adventistreview.org/do-adventists-have-a-beef-with-pope-francis>**

14. Note: Persecution came upon God's faithful people and their human rights were trampled underfoot, because they made efforts to hinder the completion of the building of the Tower of Babel.

“The men of Babel had determined to establish a government that should be independent of God. There were some among them, however, who feared the Lord, but who had been deceived by the pretensions of the ungodly and drawn into their schemes. For the sake of these faithful ones the Lord delayed His judgments and gave the people time to reveal their true character. As this was developed, the sons of God labored to turn them from their purpose; but the people were fully united in their Heaven-daring undertaking...Many seek to make a heaven for themselves by obtaining riches and power. They ‘speak wickedly concerning oppression: they speak loftily’ (Psalm 73:8), trampling upon human rights and disregarding divine authority. The proud may be for a time in great power, and may see success in all that they undertake; but in the end they will find only disappointment and wretchedness.” {PP 123.1 and 124.2}

15. Note: The application is that Pope Francis is presently laying the groundwork to persecute God's commandment-keeping people who live and preach the three angels' messages of Revelation 14:6-12. To confirm read carefully the following news reports.

"Francis also spoke out strongly again against religious fundamentalism, saying that fundamentalism exists in all religions and should be combatted with efforts at friendship. 16. Note: Pope Francis implicated and condemned himself with the above words. Bear in mind that Pope Francis is a professed Jesuit. And the Jesuit organization is an extremist group within the Roman Catholic Church. The Bible says that the Roman Catholic Church, the Papacy, is likened unto a leopard; which means that she will not change. Additionally, the Bible says that the Papacy blasphemes God. See Revelation 13:1-5; Revelation 17:1-6.

17. What are the objectives of the Jesuits? _____

"Throughout Christendom, Protestantism was menaced by formidable foes. The first triumphs of the Reformation past, Rome summoned new forces, hoping to accomplish its destruction. **At this time the order of the Jesuits was created,** the most cruel, unscrupulous, and powerful of all the champions of popery. **Cut off from earthly ties and human interests, dead to the claims of natural affection,** reason and conscience wholly silenced, they knew no rule, no tie, but that of their order, and no duty but to extend its power...**Vowed to perpetual poverty and humility, it was their studied aim to secure wealth and power, to be devoted to the overthrow of Protestantism, and the re-establishment of the papal supremacy.** {GC 234.2} and {GC 565.4}

18. Note: Consider carefully the Jesuit oath.

"I furthermore promise and declare that I will, when opportunity present, make and wage relentless war, secretly or openly, against all heretics, Protestants and Liberals, as I am directed to do, to extirpate and exterminate them from the face of the whole earth; and that I will spare neither age, sex or condition; and that I will hang, waste, boil, flay, strangle and bury alive these infamous heretics, rip up the stomachs and wombs of their women and crush their infants' heads against the walls, in order to annihilate forever their execrable race. That when the same cannot be done openly, I will secretly use the poisoned cup, the strangulating cord, the steel of the poniard or the leaden bullet, regardless of the honor, rank, dignity, or authority of the person or persons, whatever may be their condition in life, either public or private, as I at any time may be directed so to do by any agent of the Pope or Superior of the Brotherhood of the Holy Faith, of the Society of Jesus." <http://www.reformation.org/jesuit-oath.html>

19a. Note: Who is the real fundamentalist and extremist, based on Pope Francis' definitions? Answer: Pope Francis and the Jesuits. See Matthew 12:37 and Revelation 13:1-5 and Revelation 17:1-6.

19b. While the world is focusing on fighting against extremists in Islam, they are accepting the greatest extremists, namely the Jesuits.

20. Note: Based on the above conclusions, Pope Francis is really a wolf in sheep's clothing. <http://vaticaninsider.lastampa.it/en/the-vatican/detail/articolo/francesco-africa-44891/>

21. How will the above conclusions affect God's commandment-keeping people? Answer: Pope Francis says that fundamentalists are people who claim to have absolute truth. Additionally, the Pope said that the nations and religions must unite to fight against them.

22. Note: Pope Francis is threatening God's commandment-keeping people, true Seventh-day Adventists. Pope has given God's people two options. He says that if we want peace just emphasize **"the promotion of peace, care for the poor, and environmental protection."** If we want a fight, then preach the three angels' messages of Revelation 14:6-12 and receive persecution.

23. Note: God's commandment-keeping people are in a similar position as was the apostle Peter. How did Peter respond in that time of crisis? Acts 5:28 and 29 _____

24. What did Jesus say to Peter before the crisis hour? Luke 22:31,32 _____

25. How did Peter respond to Jesus? Luke 22:33 _____

26. What did Jesus prophesy to Peter showing him that he was not ready? Luke 22:34 _____

27. Note: The two entities that united to put Jesus into prison and put Him to death were church and state, the Jewish people and Roman leaders. Therefore, the sifting time that Jesus warned Peter of was the time when church and state would unite to persecute God's people.

28. Note: When that final sifting time comes for God's people at the Mark of the Beast crisis, some will be put into prison while others will be put to death for the truth's sake.

29a. What was going on among the disciples prior to the crisis, as a result Jesus told Peter that he was not ready for the crisis? Luke 22:24

29b. Note: The Greek word translated “strife” means to have a quarrel, a dispute, a contention, and to compete with another person.

30. Note: Just before the crisis, the disciples were possessed with the spirit of Satan, because Satan was the first who desired to be the greatest in God’s kingdom. As a result, Satan fell.

31. However, what does the Lord say, showing that we must have His mind? Philippians 2:3-5 _____

32. Who will not be ready to stand for God’s truth at that time of crisis? _____
“The time is not far distant when the test will come to every soul. The mark of the beast will be urged upon us. **Those who have step by step yielded to worldly demands and conformed to worldly customs** will not find it a hard matter to yield to the powers that be, **rather than subject themselves to derision, insult, threatened imprisonment, and death.**” {5T 81.1}

33. How did Peter respond when the three tests came to him? Luke 22:54-60 _____

34. What did Jesus do in an attempt to get the disciples and Peter ready for the crisis, so that they would not be sifted out by Satan? Luke 22:15-20 _____

35. Note: If Peter had contemplated and remembered the words and actions of Jesus in the upper room that He was willing to give His life for him, then Peter would have been strengthened to give his life for Jesus.

36. Note: The application is that we must meditate daily on the fact that Jesus gave His life willingly for our salvation, we should be willing to give our lives for Him. By beholding Jesus’ life and sacrifice, we become changed in His lovely image.
“It would be well for us to spend a thoughtful hour each day in contemplation of the life of Christ. We should take it point by point, and let the imagination grasp each scene, especially the closing ones. As we thus dwell upon His great sacrifice for us, our confidence in Him will be more constant, our love will be quickened, and we shall be more deeply imbued with His spirit. If we would be saved at last, we must learn the lesson of penitence and humiliation at the foot of the cross.” {DA 83.4}

37. What did Jesus say in the presence of the betrayer, Judas Iscariot? Luke 22:21 _____

38. A few moments before, what did Jesus say, even to Judas? Luke 22:20 _____

39. In other words, Jesus told Judas, “the grape juice that you drank represents my blood that will be shed for your salvation; yet you are going to sell me out for 30 pieces of silver. Is that all I am worth to you? After all that I have done for you Judas, you are going to sell me out?” Bear in mind this fact, Judas was sifted out by Satan, because he loved money more than Jesus, His truth, and salvation.

40. Note: Again, if Peter had remembered that the cup that Jesus gave him to drink was a symbol of Jesus giving His life for him, he would have received power to be willing to give his life for Jesus and not to deny Him.

41. What else did Jesus say to Peter just before the crisis, that Peter should have remembered in order to have strength to stand? Luke 22:32 _____

42. Note: Peter walked with Jesus for 3 1/2 years and saw the powerful effects of Jesus’ prayers. Peter saw the fact that Jesus’ words and prayers multiplied five loaves and two fishes to feed at least 5000 people, calmed the stormy seas to save people’s lives, healed the sick, and raised the dead to life. Yet in the crisis hour, Peter forgot the power and efficiency of Jesus’ prayer of intercession for him.

43. Note: Seventh-day Adventists above every other people should stand in these last days, because they profess to believe the fact that Jesus, as High Priest, is presently interceding in the Most Holy Place of the Heavenly of Sanctuary.

44. Note: If Peter had remembered the power and efficiency of Jesus’ intercessory prayer, his faith would not have failed in the crisis hour. We must also take heed to that point.

“The subject of the sanctuary and the investigative judgment should be clearly understood by the people of God. All need a knowledge for themselves of the position and work of their great High Priest. **Otherwise it will be impossible for them to exercise the faith which is essential at this time or to occupy the position which God designs them to fill.** Every individual has a soul to save or to lose. Each has a case pending at the bar of God. Each must meet the great Judge face to face. How important, then, that every mind contemplate often the solemn scene when the judgment shall sit and the books shall be opened, when, with Daniel, every individual must stand in his lot, at the end of the days.” {GC 488.2}

45. What was Jesus’ instruction to Peter? Luke 22:32 _____
In other words, Jesus said to Peter “once you receive this true experience, share it with your brethren.” Likewise, the Lord is saying the same to us.
